of Goa are directed to furnish all information that the CEC may  
require for making its report for the Court in light of the Shah  
Commission's report.

A preliminary report from the CEC should reach this Court  
within four weeks from today.

Put up on receipt of the report from the CEC.

Till further orders, all mining operations in the leases  
identified in the Shah Commission's report and transportation of  
iron ore and manganese ore from those leases, whether lying at the  
mine-head or stockyards, shall remain suspended, as recommended in  
the Commission's report.
